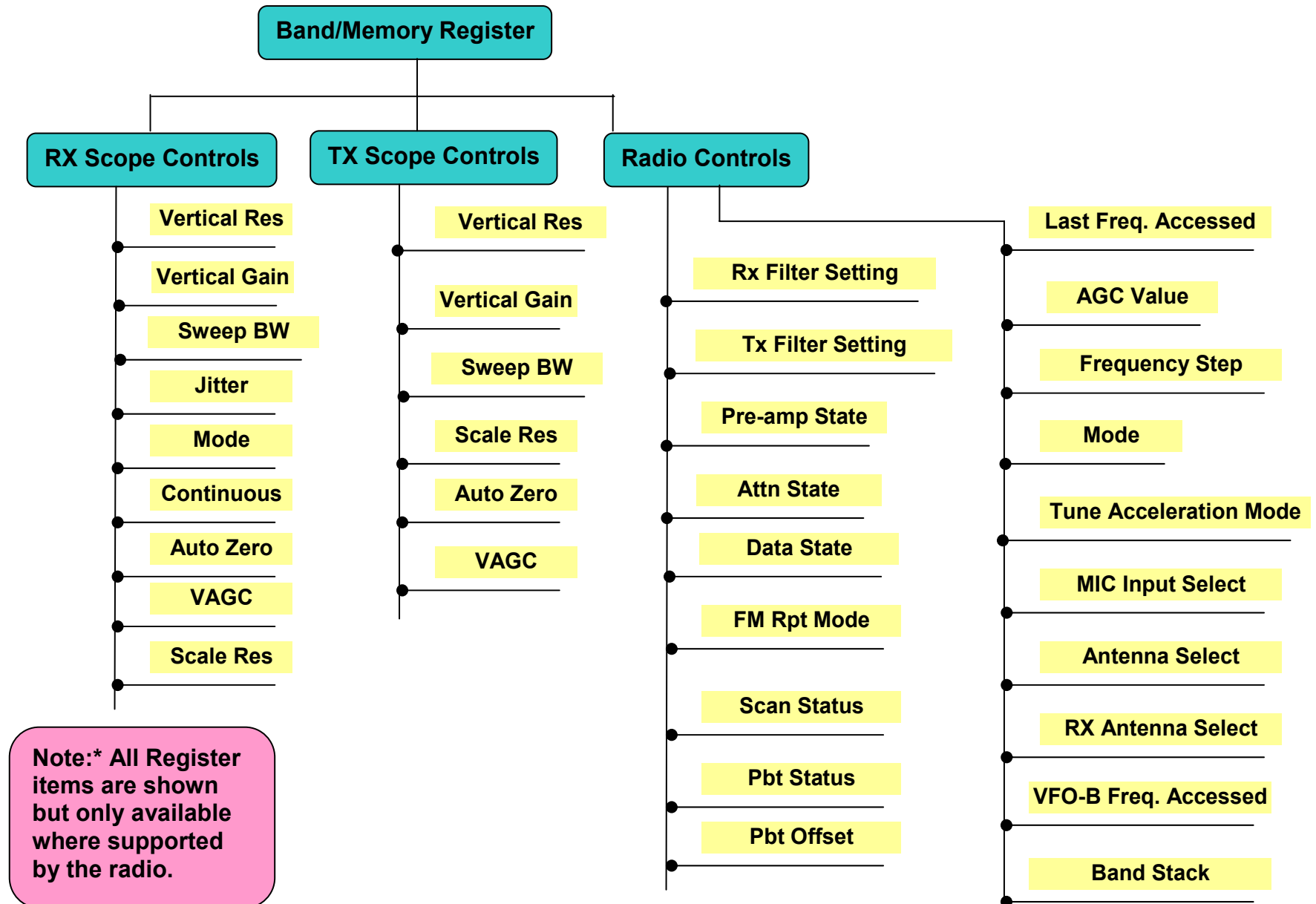
Disclaimer:

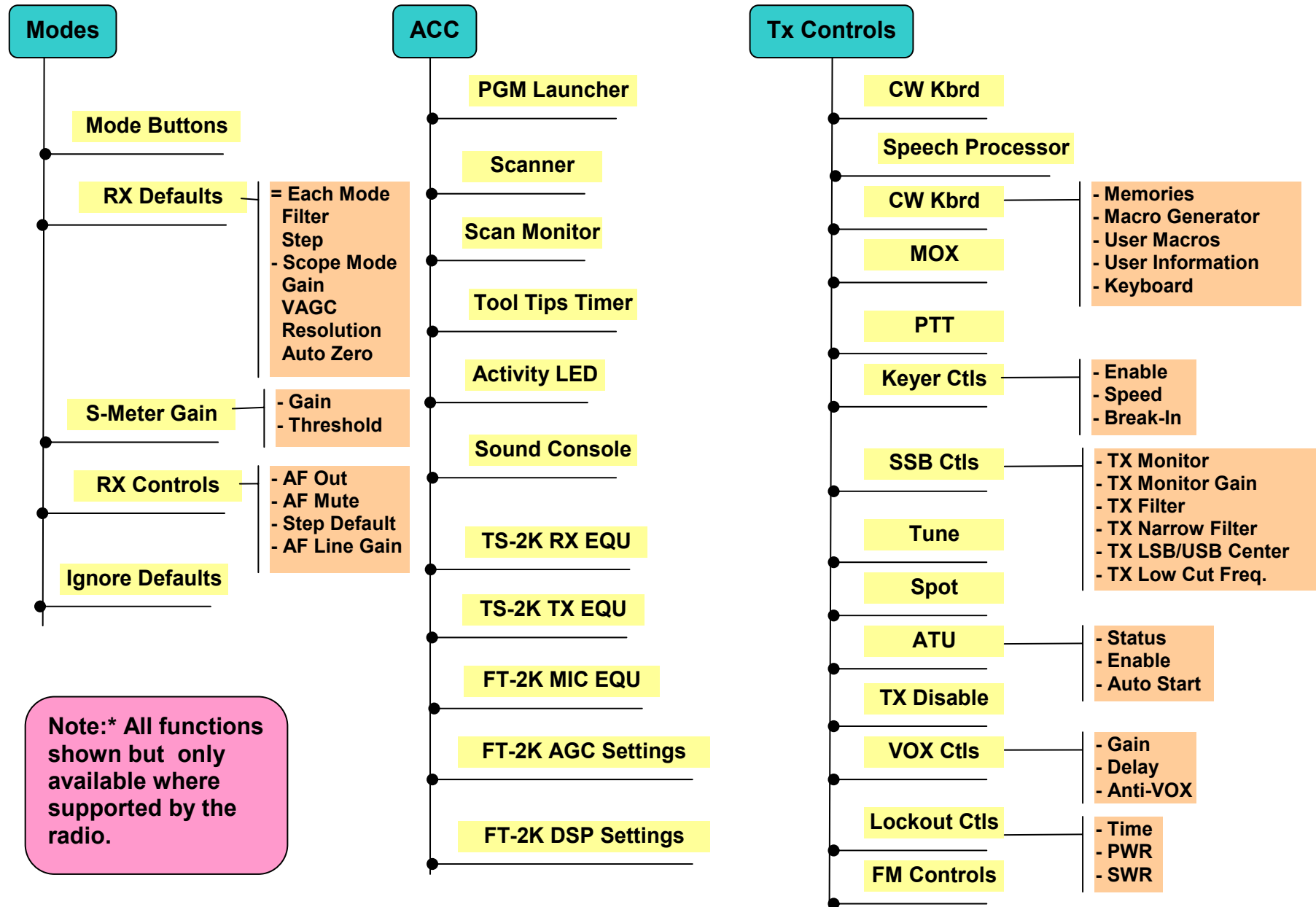
This roadmap is intended to give a general overview of where things are and how they may be reached.

This is a “live” software package. As such as improvements and changes are made to the software, sections of this guide may become out of date until it catches up.

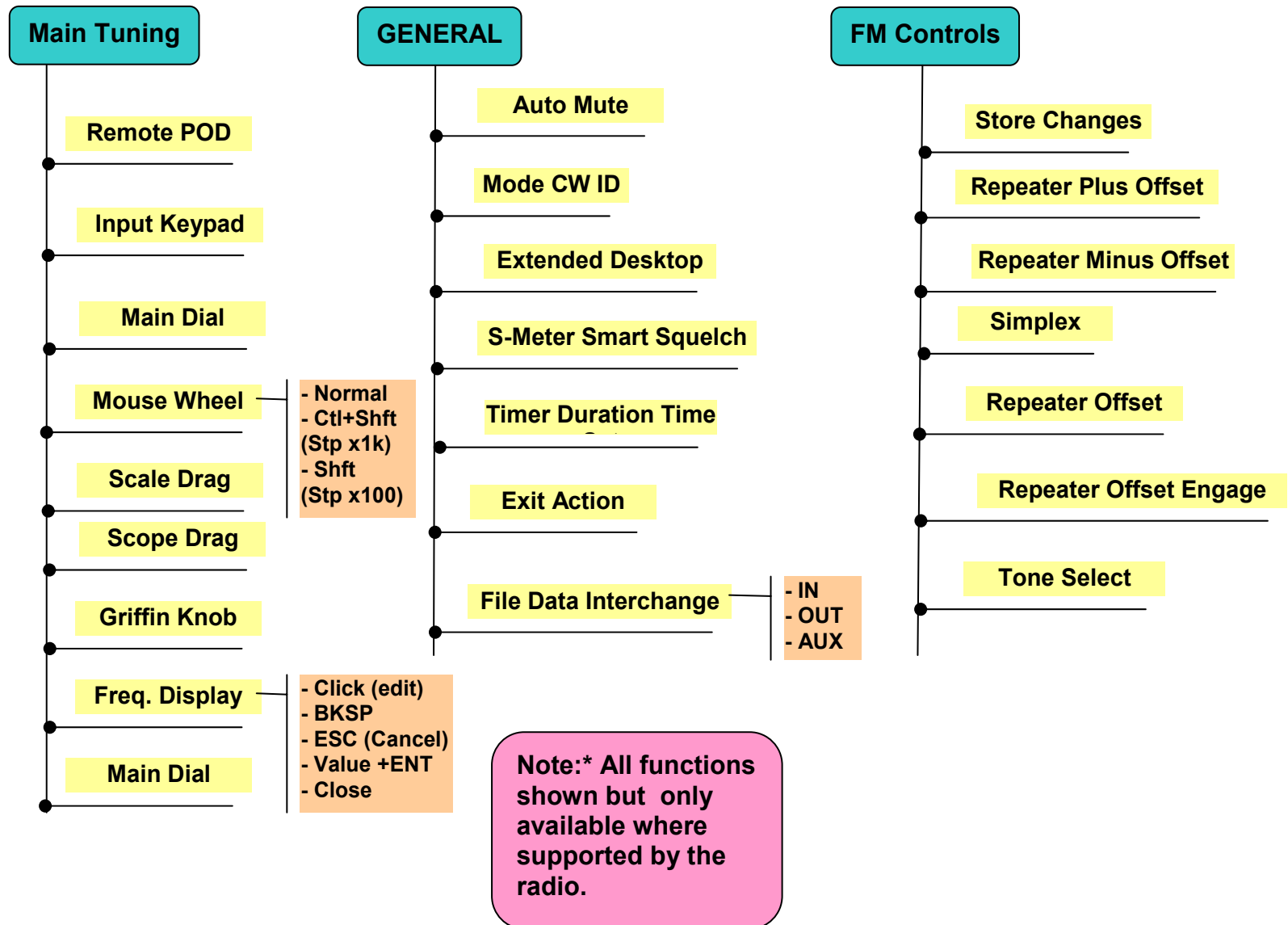

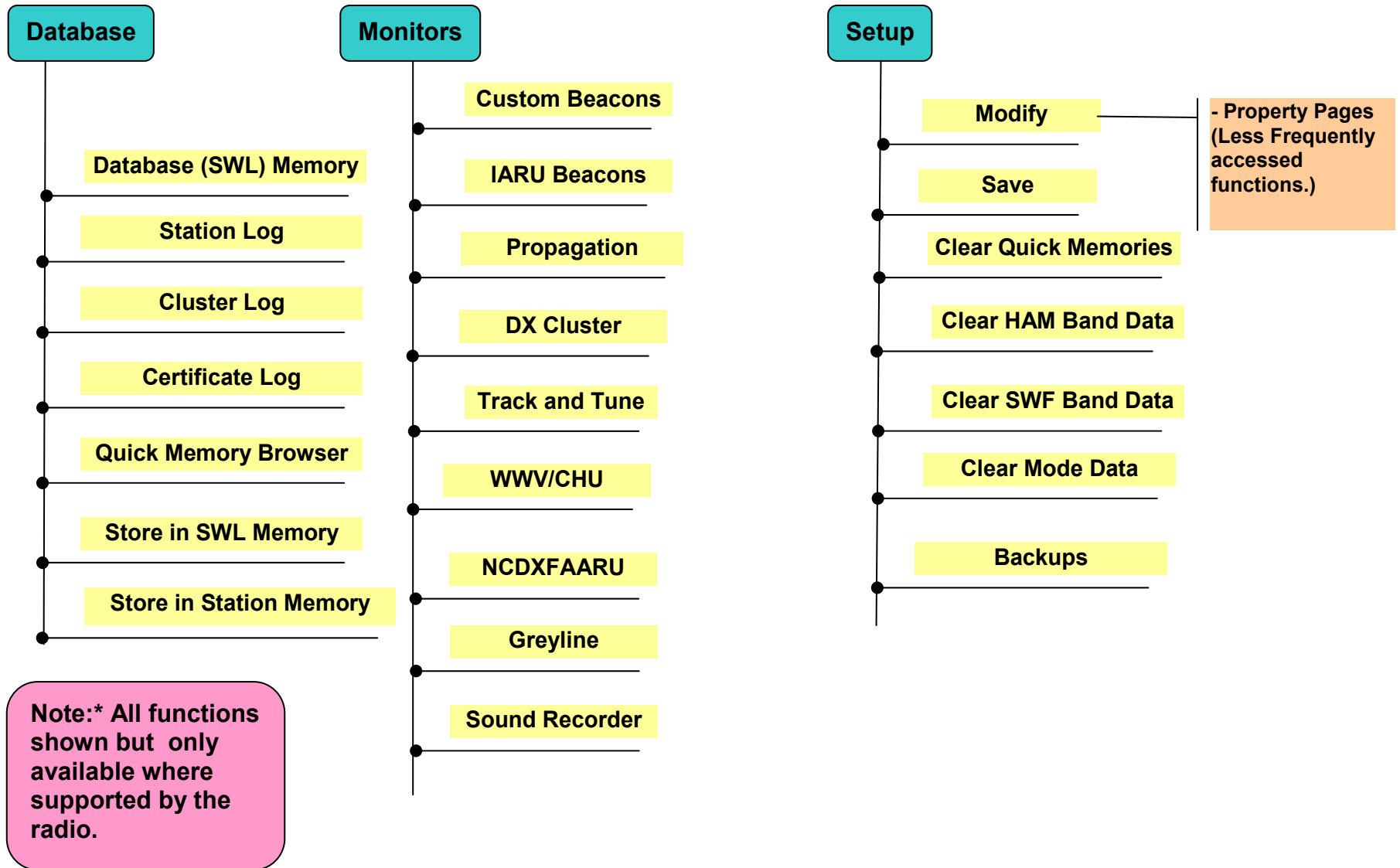
3. Modes, ACC and TX Tool Bars



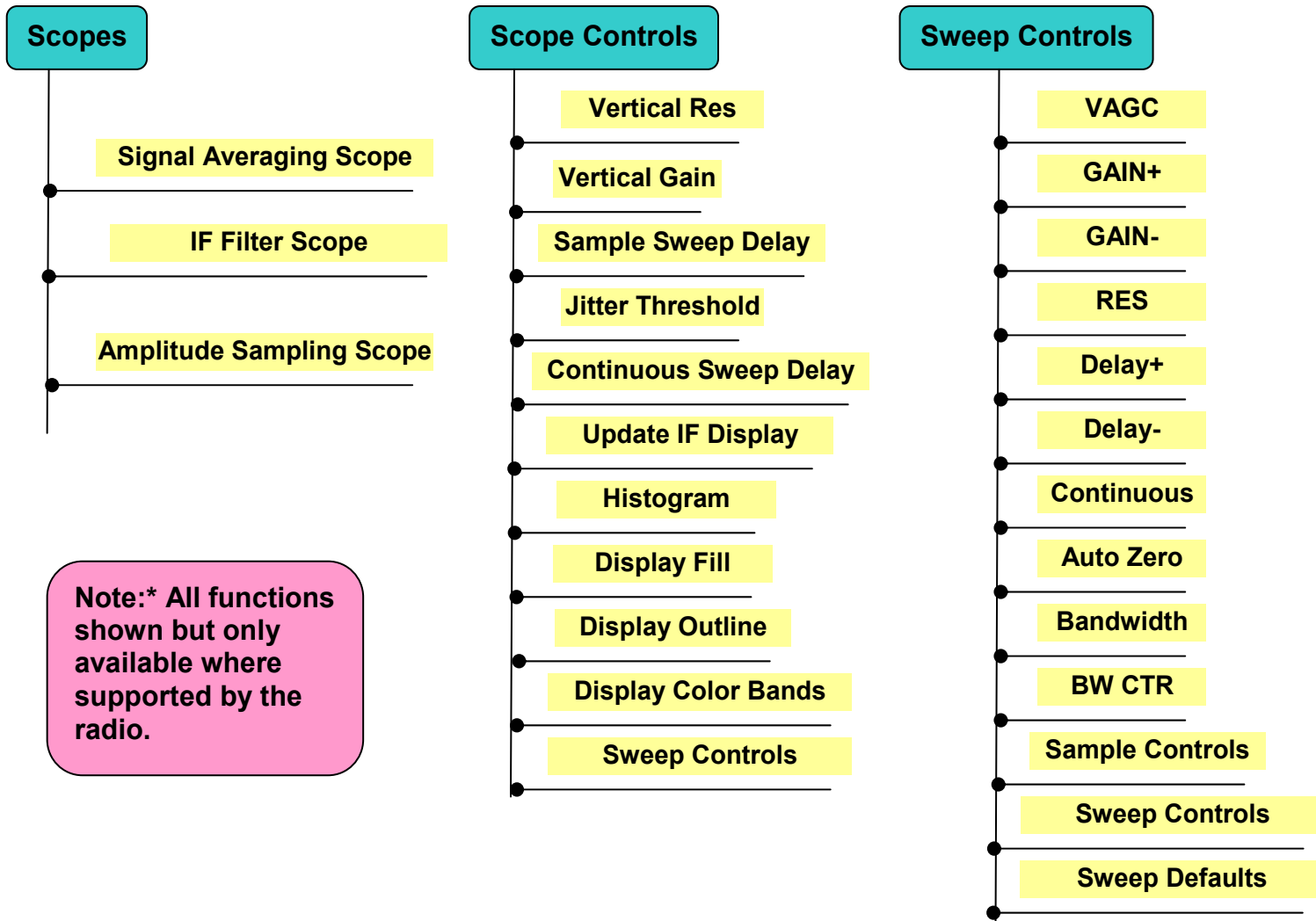
4. Tuning Controls, General and FM Tool Bars



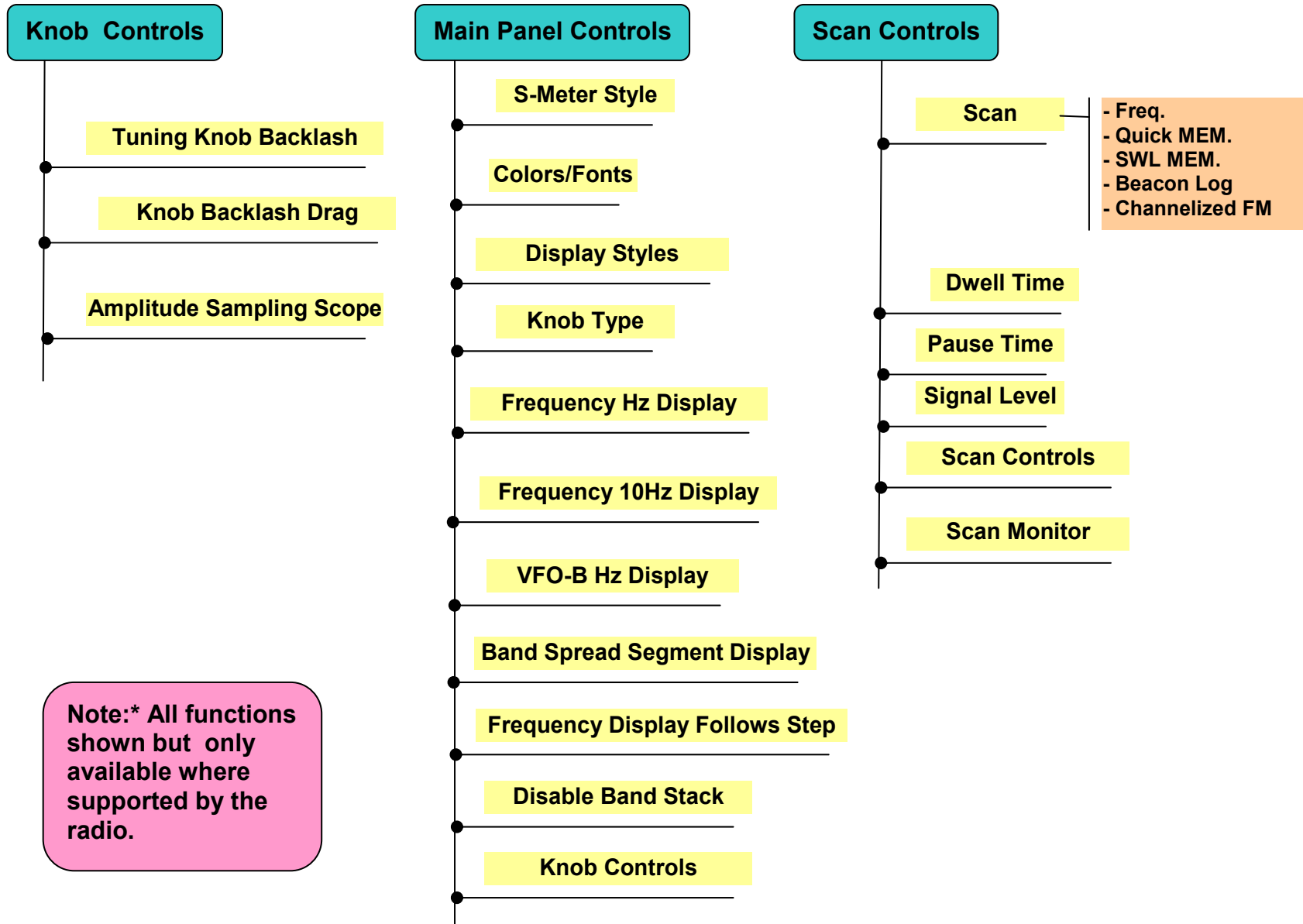
5. Database, Monitors, and Setup Tool Bars



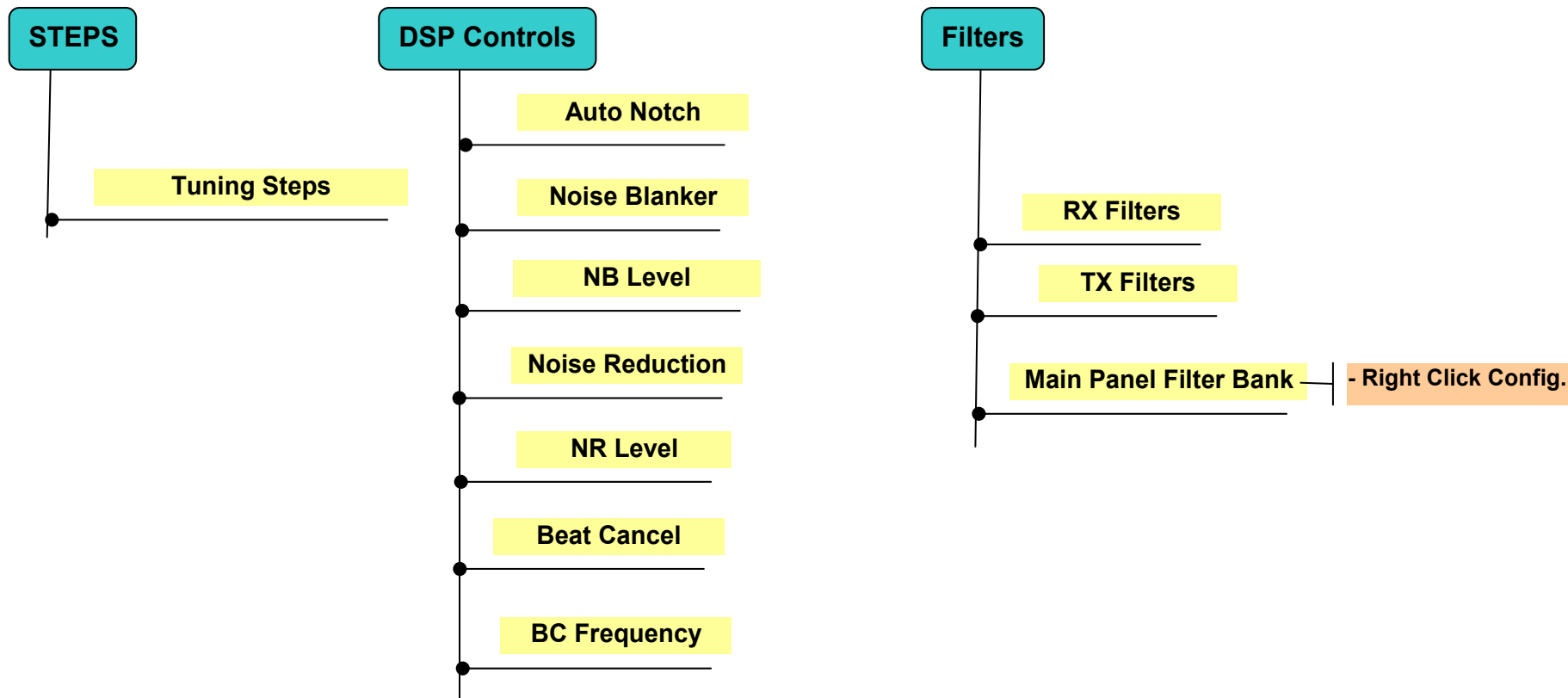
6. Scopes, Scope Controls, and Sweep Control Tool Bars



7. Knob Spin Control, Main Panel Layout Controls, and Scan Control Tool Bars

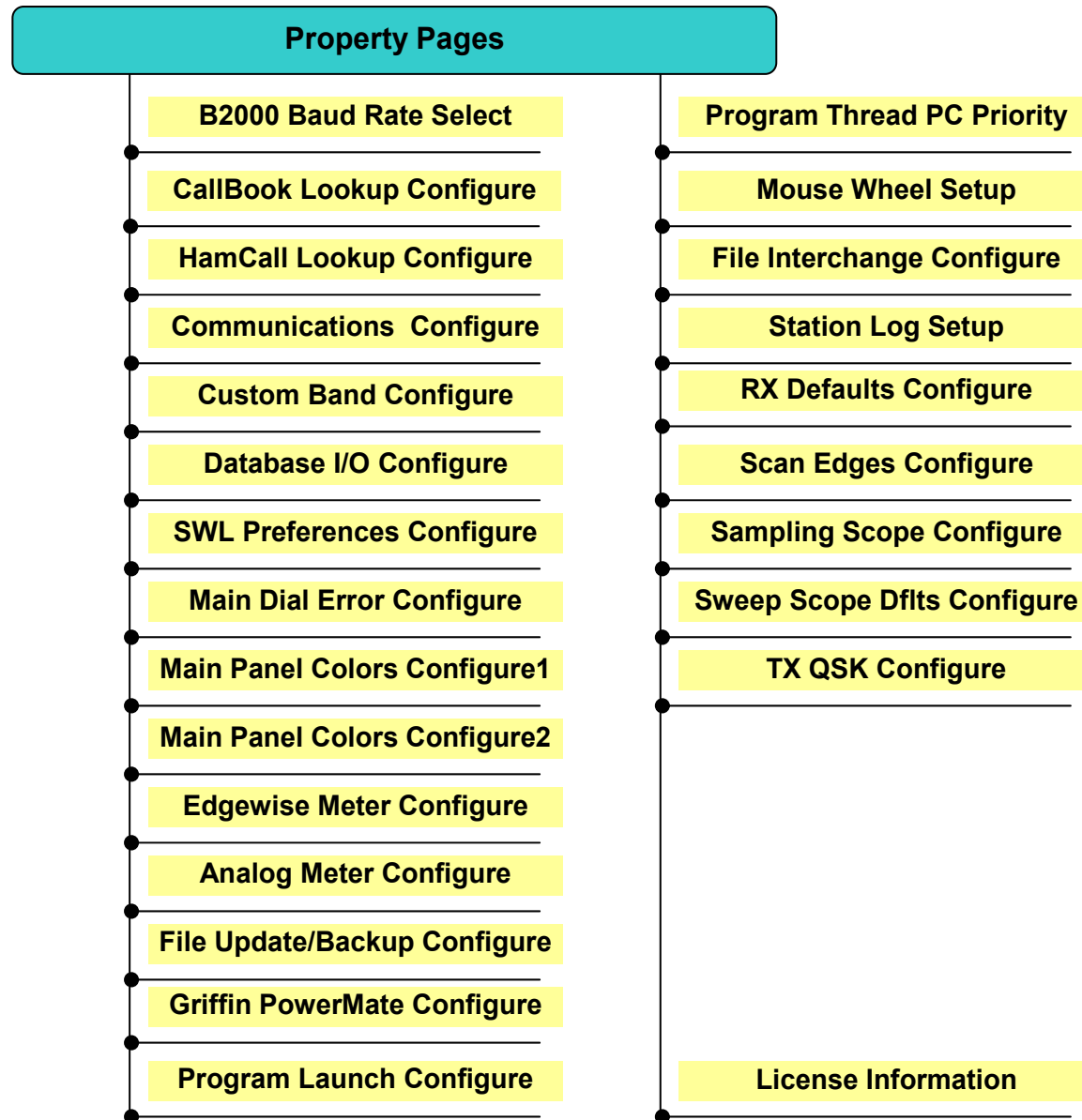
